

SAT Prep: (grades 9-12) Online Only

(Anticipated 2018/19 test dates: Aug 25, Oct 6, Nov 3, Dec 1, March 9, May 4, June 1)

It is preferable that students take a course that ends BEFORE the test date. However, if the test is looming and you didn't plan ahead, you will still benefit as long as the test is no more than two weeks before the course end date. See course schedule below: the first six weeks contain the most necessary information. Ideally, you should complete the course at least 2-4 weeks (or more) before the test date in order to review the skills covered.

(Note: Students intending to take the August SAT should visit our Summer Course Description for the summer schedule.)

This course will present students with tips and techniques for taking the new SAT. Students will strengthen their critical thinking & reasoning skills, improve their vocabularies, and practice math strategies. They will also complete practice tests and essays. Online quizzes, practice tests, and lessons combine with student led discussion forums and weekly assignments which are reviewed and assessed by the teacher.

This course is intended for students who are motivated to learn specific test taking skills and techniques. To get the most out of the math section, students should be enrolled in (or have completed) Geometry by the time they take this course. This class will provide students with the tools to help them take the SAT successfully. They should continue to use those tools to strengthen their skills even after the course ends.

Online learners will engage in interactive online lessons and weekly assessments or assignments. In addition, students will interact with other students and the teacher via weekly discussion forums and activities. Students have one week to complete the weekly lesson activities. This class runs "asynchronously" (participants to do not need to be online at a specific time each week).

Note: Students will receive an activity report and course syllabus for their own files. This course is not graded. This is a fully online class. There is no face-to-face component.
